**MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS...**

- The Site C Dam project on the northern bank of the Peace River will be a self-contained community, with its own sewage and water systems and facilities that rival nearby Fort St. John. *It is expected to house 1,800 workers when it opens early next year, with the ability to expand to eventually house 2,200 at the height of construction on the \$9 billion dam.*
- The need for energy is increasing globally, particularly in emerging Asian economies. Natural gas – the world's cleanest burning fossil fuel – is projected to increase two-and-a-half times over the next 20 years, to meet this world-wide demand for LNG. *Multiple new LNG plants on the west coast are planned, that could see Canada export 82 Megatonnes per year of LNG by 2020. This Forecast assumes 75 per cent of this gas will come from northeast B.C.*
- Alberta Transportation has approved a highway expansion project outside of Calgary starting in 2016. This \$5B project will last until 2020!
- *The need for skilled operators to replace those expected to retire over the next 10 years means thousands of more job openings are forecasted. Additionally, data collected from 19 Mines Operating in BC Project over 10,000 new jobs over the next 10 years.*
