### *Heavy Equipment Operator Training Leader...*

A day at IHE is treated like a day at work. Students arrive for their daily shift and report to a safety toolbox meeting. Starting day one, students are hands-on in their own machine (five hours daily) as they learn the basics of work-based training on excavators, dozers, articulated rock trucks, graders, wheel loaders, and rubber-tire backhoes including pre and post-operation maintenance checks. **Tasks include** rock-wall building, straight trenching, road activation and deactivation, stockpiling, backfilling, slope trenching, leveling, laser-level use, and many more depending on time of year and the students’ own ability. Studying theory topics like surveying, slopes, soil, maintenance, resume building & much more is also accomplished online and in the field.

Safety is the backbone of our culture and philosophy. We emphasize it at every stage of the training. Safety is our primary focus with our students, employees, partners, and visitors alike. It is the hallmark of our industry recognized training programs, all resulting in one thing:
